There's a very warm welcome to all of you to join us for a cuppa and have a chat to our guests.

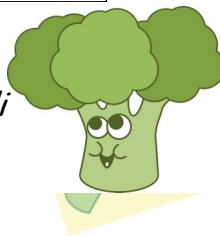
